The NYC-based band, led by guitarist Jeremy Hilliard, a versatile singer-songwriter, has been performing in its current incarnation since 2019. 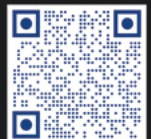

# ZACK KEIM

**Rock**

Zack Keim blends folk, blues, and garage rock, earning acclaim across the U.S. and Europe. Named WYEP's 2025 Pittsburgh Artist of the Year and featured by the Pittsburgh Penguins during the 2025–2026 season, he is emerging as one of Pittsburgh's standout voices. He brings his full band to SummerSounds, performing songs from his new album *Battery Lane* on CAAMP's Super Sport Records.

Born in Blawnox and raised near Latrobe roots, the 29-year-old singer-songwriter has played music most of his life. He picked up guitar in middle school, playing along to his father's Beatles records, influenced by Bob Dylan and The Beatles. At 16, he formed Nox Boys, later signing with Get Hip Records.

After moving to Washington, D.C., and a cancelled European tour during COVID, he began writing *Battery Lane* while living in an apartment of the same name. He explored piano, organ, synths, and keys while returning to guitar, shaping the critically acclaimed album.

# ARISTOTLE JONES

**Americana / Soul**



Aristotle Jones, known as the Appalachian Soul Man, has a story to tell through music.

Drawing inspiration from his home in the heart of the West Virginia's coal country, Aristotle Jones imbues his music with a mix of mountain doo-wop, soulful harmony, rich acoustic tones and rhythm and blues. And he's bringing it to the SummerSounds stage.

Listen and you'll hear the hints of Motown, church choirs and funk that shaped the Appalachian Soul Man's unique take on Americana. But it is in rich, detail-studded story-telling that this singer-songwriter's heartfelt poetry comes through. His deep, personal narrative, told through warm vocals,

takes us on a tour of the mountain region that birthed his artistry. There is so much more to West Virginia, he seems to say, than blue-grass, country and old school banjo music.

Backed by the sound of a six-man band, Aristotle Jones takes a soulful, funky deep dive into the universal themes of family and heritage. He sings of resilient people who've endured through the hard times, surviving poverty, Jim Crow, and the struggle for civil rights to emerge whole through the power of love and music.

"It's in my roots, my soul and in that air that I breathe," Jones was quoted in a recent interview when asked to describe his music.

Bill Toms is a Steel town original. His Pittsburgh roots shine through in a mix of gritty, blue-collar soul and blues every time Bill Toms & Hard Rain take the stage.

Backed by a combination of soulful horns, keyboards, guitar, bass and percussion that comprise the band, Bill Toms & Hard Rain offers a mix of covers and original music that tell a working-class tale with heartfelt authenticity straight from the gut of one who's been there.

Toms, the band's front man, began his musical career in 1987 as lead guitarist with Joe Grushecky and the House Rockers. During a decade with the House Rockers, he opened for and played with legends including Bob Dylan, Bruce Springsteen and Stevie Ray Vaughn.

Toms took away a masters' degree in rock and soulful blues from that period and went on to craft his own no-frills sound based in tales of life, love and the power of resilience.

Even so, his important early musical influences still echo in his work. The band's most recent album "It's All We're Fighting For," highlights Toms' strong song-writing chops and powerful vocals in cuts like "Give a Poor Man a Quarter" and "Shake and Shout."

River city brass concerts. And we're sure more than a few fans know the words to rock favorites like "Renegade," and "Carry on Wayward Son."

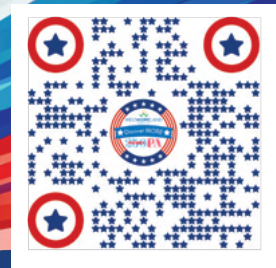
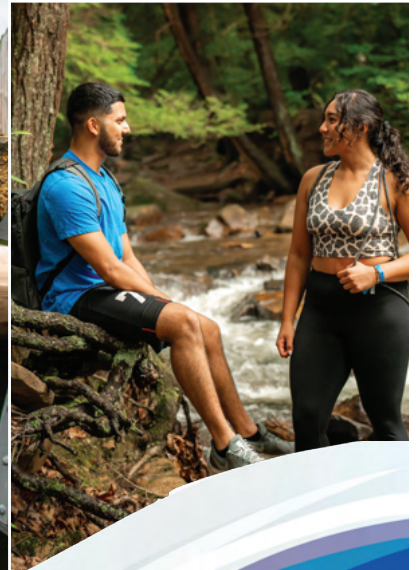

# ST. CLAIR PARK AT AMERICA 250

St. Clair Park has been a public space since Greensburg's founding in 1786 when William Jack set aside the sprawling ten-acre site for use by the frontier town's citizens to pasture their cattle and horses. For more than two centuries, the site has continued to serve the community as a site for the town's first church and burial ground; for an early public school; and St. Clair Cemetery, widely considered one of the most beautiful and progressive cemeteries in Western Pennsylvania until burials were no longer prohibited in within city limits and the cemetery was moved in the late nineteenth century.

Throughout the twentieth century, the former cemetery ground evolved as a public park and venue for a board mix of recreational, cultural, and educational events. Since 2000, the park and the Robertshaw Amphitheater has been the setting for SummerSounds, widely considered one of the best events of its kind in Western Pennsylvania and recently ranked by U. S. A. Today as second best local outdoor concerts in the nation.

Seemingly lost among the park's quiet, tree-lined walkways are tributes to two men who made significant contributions to the birth of the American nation – the grave of Arthur St. Clair and a bronze life-sized statue of General Nathanael Greene. Scottish-born Arthur St. Clair Sinclair first served in the British army officer during the French and Indian War, and later served as the Penn government's representative in the development of the Western Pennsylvania frontier and is widely considered the founder of Westmoreland County in 1763. As a Major General in the Continental Army, St. Clair commanded American troops and served

as General George Washington's Aide de Camp, during the American Revolution. After the war, St. Clair was appointed the first governor of the Northwest Territory, an area of the United States that eventually became the states of Ohio, Illinois, Michigan, Indiana, and part of Minnesota. In 1803. When St. Clair died at his home near Ligonier in 1818 his fellow masons honored him by interring him and his wife, Phoebe Bayard under a granite monument on the grounds of the site later named in his honor - St. Clair Cemetery.

Nathanael Greene, Quaker-born Rhode Island native is widely considered by historians as one of the most consequential generals of the American Revolution. Military professionals cite his command and military conduct of the Continental Army during the Southern campaign to have broken the back of the British war effort in America and the eventual surrender of the British Army at Yorktown to end the war. Greensburg men who served under Greene's command, named their hometown in his honor. Greene's statue in St. Clair Park was created in 1999 by nationally renowned Ligonier-born artist, Chas Fagan whose works include President Ronald Reagan's statue in the Rotunda of the U. S. Capitol; First Lady Barbara Bush's official White House portrait; and the official canonization portrait of Mother Teresa in the Vatican in Rome.

Matt Schofield, widely hailed as one of the best six-string blues guitarists England has ever produced, is his bringing his distinctive sound to Greensburg's SummerSounds stage.

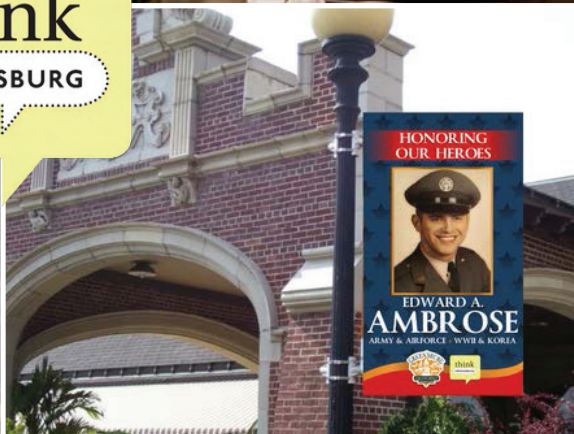

The numerous billiard halls and membership clubs of the early 1900s have been replaced with coffee shops, specialty retail stores, and tattoo

shops. New apartments with modern style and features complement the historic houses of the Academy Hill National Historic District.

The city has maintained outstanding desirability as a place to live. Residents have pride in their neighborhoods featuring tree-lined streets, sidewalks, neighborhood businesses, public green space, and community parks. Two major universities bookend the city providing opportunities to earn a degree and experience lectures and performances. Seton Hill University and the University of Pittsburgh at Greensburg are not only education centers but significant contributors to the local economy. City residents enjoy year-round entertainment with proximity to many key

entertainment, cultural, and recreational amenities. The Five Star walking/biking trail, Mt. Odin Golf Course, Lynch Field, and Kirk Nevin Arena provide residents with ample outdoor recreation opportunities. The SummerSounds concerts at the Robertshaw Amphitheater in St. Clair Park balance the fall and winter event schedules of the Palace Theatre, Westmoreland Museum of American Art, and Seton Hill University Performing Arts Center. The Cultural District is strengthened by several arts related entrepreneurs, galleries and performance venues.

Equally important factors making Greensburg a unique place to live are the retail stores of the downtown shopping district and houses of worship. The numerous restaurants, cafés and bars located throughout the city make it a fun, unique place to live and are a key part of the popularity of Greensburg. In many ways, Greensburg reflects our society and the region while possessing an appreciation of our history.

The Greensburg Community Development Corporation (GCDC) supports the efforts of residents, business owners and developers who want to ensure that this unique community remains a great place to live, work, and visit.
